The Migrants Commission is seeking to recruit a Support Worker on a full-time basis. The successful applicant will report to the Residence Coordinator, Migrants Commission, and will ensure that those who seek assistance, in particular migrants and their families, are cared for and protected while moving towards independent living. S/he needs to endeavour to promote the persons' best interest at all times.

The ideal candidate must:

- Have a minimum of 2 years' experience within the social welfare and community field. Frontline experience in working with migrants and/or a certificate in caring, will be considered an asset.
- Have a person-centred approach to working with migrants and their families.
- Be resourceful and able to perform under pressure.
- Be able to work independently and as part of a team.
- Have strong written and verbal communication skills, particularly in the English language. Speaking diverse languages will be considered an asset.
